A special meeting of the Town Board of Vernon was held at 6:30 p.m. on the above date at the Town Office Building to choose a web designer for the Town website. Council members present: Myron J. Thurston, Supervisor; Gene Bennati, Mick McDonough and Randy Watson. Sandy Williams was absent. Also present: John Douglas Sr. and Frank Laguzza, Assessor.

Following the Pledge of Allegiance, the meeting was called to order by Supervisor Thurston at 6:30 p.m.

Patrick Cronn from CronnJob Consulting LLC, who designed the Town's original website discussed what he could do to change it. The cost would be between \$300 and \$400 plus a \$50 monthly fee if there were changes to be made. Mr. Cronn could not get on our wireless internet to show his presentation.

Charles Thompson from No Sheep Design also discussed what he could do to change the website. His cost would be \$375 plus a \$25 monthly fee for hosting the site. Mr. Thompson's laptop had broken earlier in the day so he could not show his presentation. The Board members asked them both to come back on May 16, 2011 to give a presentation to show their ideas.

A motion to adjourn at 7:42 p.m. was made by Bennati, seconded by McDonough. No discussion. Ayes 3. Nays 0. Motion carried.
